

**SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS
CONCERNING THE FINISHING OF FABRICS AND OF KNITTED GOODS
OF ALL KINDS (EXCEPT FOR FABRIC PRINTING),
SUPPLEMENTING THE UNIFIED CONDITIONS FOR
TEXTILE FINISHING COMMISSION ORDERS**

Registered in the Cartel Register ^{*)} according to the Announcement 28/65 of the Federal Cartel Authority (Federal Gazette No. 88/65 of May 12, 1965 and No. 218 of November 23, 1985 and No. 31 of February 14, 1986).

§ 1

Finishing Price

The finishing price applies exclusively to the finishing processes determined by colour groups and by the required specifications as well as by quantity and quality.

§ 2

Re-measuring, Re-weighing and Marking of the Grey Goods

- (1) The finisher is not obliged to re-measure or to re-weigh the grey goods. If this is specifically requested by the customer, an extra charge will be made.
- (2) Markings of the pieces by the customer (piece numbers) shall be applied at the end of the piece, preferably 50 cm from the end.

§ 3

Special and Additional Processes

An extra charge will be made for

- a) necessary extra processing which could not be foreseen upon booking the order;
- b) expenses for making-up, packing, dispatch costs and for other transport costs to and from the finisher as well as customs duties;
- c) all additional processes.

§ 4

Value of Grey Goods

On booking the order and upon request the finisher shall be advised of the approximate purchase price of the greys or of the approximate production costs in the case of self-produced goods.

§ 5

Finishing Instructions

- (1) On placing the order, precise instructions shall be given to the finisher on the required finishing, fastness and on the end use of the goods.
- (2) Should the customer not give specific instructions, the finisher will select the dyestuffs and chemicals, taking into account the required shades and the nature of the goods.

§ 6

Expression: "One Quality"

This term shall mean goods made from the same spinning materials, from the same spun yarns, of the same origin, of the same count or the same yarn number, of the same weight, of the same grey width, of the same reed and pick and of the same weave or construction.

§ 7**Guarantee of Finished Measurements and Weight**

- (1) No guarantee will be made for a specific length or width or for a specific weight of finished goods; date relating to individual pieces or part deliveries may not be used as a basis for the whole order.
- (2) If, for a specific article and in an individual case, a definite shrinkage in length is agreed upon, the finisher shall be held liable only if this shrinkage in length is exceeded:

in elastic fabrics:

heavy milled goods

or knitted goods by more than 5 %,

in other woven fabrics by more than 2 %,

in each case based on the total quantity delivered to the finisher. If these tolerances are exceeded, a compensation shall be

paid only for the loss of length exceeding such tolerances.

§ 8**Marking of Faults and Piece Ends**

- (1) The marking of a fault by the finisher shall not exempt the customer from his obligation to inspect the finished lot.
- (2) No undertaking will be made to return the finished goods with the original ends; both ends up to 50 cm and other minor parts of the pieces which must be cut off in the normal course of finishing and make-up shall be deemed to be unavoidable waste.
